DIY Lavender Bath Salts

Materials Needed:

- 1 cup Epsom salt
- 1 cup pink extra fine grain Himalayan salt
- 6 drops of lavender essential oil
- 1/4 cup of baking soda
- Large bowl
- Spoon
- Jar with lid
- Ribbon

- Paper or cardstock
- Markers
- Scissors
- Craft glue or doublestick tape

Instructions:

- Combine Epsom salt, Himalayan salt, and baking soda. Mix well.
- 2 Add essential oil. Mix well.
- 3 Fill your jar with the bath salts.
- 4 Place the lid on paper and trace it.

- 5 Encourage your child to draw a picture or write a message.
- 6 Use scissors to cut out the picture.
- 7 Glue the picture to the top of the lid.
- 8 Add ribbon for a decorative touch.
- Attach our bath salts tag.



DIY Hot Cocoa Mix

Materials Needed:

- 2 cups of confectioners' sugar
- 1 cup of unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2 cups of powdered milk or instant nonfat dry milk
- 1 bag of mini marshmallows
- Flour sifter
- Large bowl
- Whisk
- Spoon

- Jar with lid
- Ribbon
- Paper or cardstock
- Markers
- Scissor
- Craft glue

Instructions:

- Sift the confectioners' sugar into a large bowl,
- 2 Then sift the unsweetened coca into the bowl. Try to eliminate lumps.
- 3 Stir in the powdered milk and whisk well until everything is combined.
- 4 Spoon mixture into jar.
- 5 Add mini marshmallows on top of the mixture. Secure lid.

- 6 Place the lid on paper and trace it.
- 7 Encourage your child to draw a picture or write a message.
- 8 Use scissors to cut out the picture.
- Glue the picture to the top of the lid.
- 10 Add ribbon for a decorative touch.
- 11 Attach our hot cocoa tag.
