

Try this fun science activity with your little one.

Materials Needed:

- Milk
- Dish Soap
- Red Food Coloring
- Clear or White Dish
- Valentine Cookie Cutter
- Q-Tips

Instructions:

- Add enough milk to cover the bottom of the white or clear dish.
- Place the valentine cookie cutter in the middle of the dish.
- Add a few drops of the red food coloring to the milk inside the cookie cutter.
- Dip a Q-Tip in the dish soap and dab it on the food coloring.
- Use a dry Q-tip to swirl the colors and create beautiful designs!

Questions:

- 1. What happened when the dish soap touched the food coloring?
- 2. Did everything eventually mix together?
- 3. What color did this experiment create?
