Guidelines for Books



Reach Out and Read's focus is on children between the ages of 6 months and 5 years, although books for older children may be accepted, depending on the needs of individual programs.



Hardcover picture books with brightly colored pictures and interesting stories are ideal.




Donated books should be developmentally appropriate and culturally appropriate. Books about sensitive issues or books which include any reference to religious worship or instruction cannot be accepted.



Used books must be "gently-used" (covers and pages intact, clean, and readable).







Note: Reach Out and Read only distributes new children's books in the exam room during regular pediatric checkups, but used books are often used in the waiting room, given away to children who come for a sick visit, or given to siblings who do not have an appointment that day, but would like a book to take home as well.
